In our geography lessons, we will be learning about the difference between weather and climate. We will investigate flooding and the impact it has on our local community.

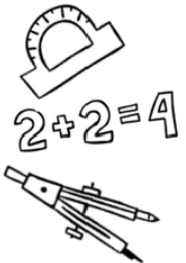


In our history lessons, we will be learning about the Roman invasion in Britain.



As Mathematicians this term:

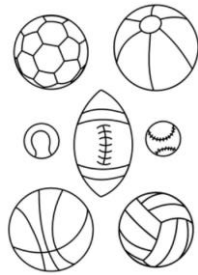
We will be learning about place value with numbers up to 1 million, being able to accurately order, compare and recognise the value of each digit.

As Artists this term:

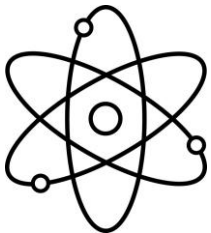
We will recap our knowledge of sketching techniques and use charcoal to create a self portrait in the style of L. S. Lowry.
